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#### 2. PROFILE

Alessandro Panunzi, PhD in Linguistics, is currently associate professor at the University of Florence, where he teaches *Linguistics* and *Corpus Linguistics*. At the same university, he is member of the LABLITA (Italian Linguistic Laboratory) Research Unit and of the *Philology, Italian literature and Linguistics* Ph.D. Program Board (since 2014). He also teaches *General Linguistics* at the Catholic University of the Sacred Heart (Bolzano campus), and he has been invited professor at the Federal University of Minas Gerais (UFMG, Belo Horizonte) and in University of Warsaw.

He took part in national and international projects devoted to the constitution and exploitation of language resources. He has been principal investigator coordinator of the project MODELACT (*From Individuation to Modeling in Natural Language Ontology of Action*; MIUR program Futuro in Ricerca 2012). He is currently responsible for the University of Florence research unit in the project IMPAQTS (*Implicit Manipulation in Politics - Quantitatively Assessing the Tendentiousness of Speeches*; MIUR program PRIN 2017).

His research interests range over spoken language analysis, corpus linguistics, prosody, pragmatics, lexical semantics, cognitive linguistics and computational linguistics. The core areas of his research are the correlation between prosodic forms and pragmatic functions in spontaneous speech, and the study of semantics properties of the verb lexicon starting from corpus analysis.
